

Harvest Preparatory Academy Visitor Policy

We encourage our parents to visit the classrooms, volunteer on campus, and attend class/school activities. For safety reasons, all visitors must report to the office to sign in and show a valid ID to receive a visitor's pass while on campus. For those who wish to volunteer their time in the classroom, or other areas of the school, a volunteer form must be on file at the front office. Visiting the classrooms must be arranged in advance with the teacher. Approval from the principal may also be required. Some limitations (during testing, etc.) may apply.

While on campus, visitors are asked to demonstrate respect for school rules, including not smoking or bringing alcoholic beverages on campus, and dressing modestly. Please avoid conferencing with the teacher during classroom visits. Remember, visits should not disrupt the academic learning process and teachers are expected to conduct class as usual.

All school volunteer time and tours are optional, but highly encouraged to help our families stay connected to the learning opportunities given to their children at Harvest Preparatory Academy.

The district may not impose any requirement to wear a mask or face covering anywhere on the governmental entity's premises, except where long-standing workplace safety and infection control measures unrelated to COVID-19 may be required.

Administrators may refuse anyone a visitor pass. Any person found on school grounds without permission will be considered a trespasser and subject to school violation regulations and full effect of the laws that govern trespassing
